

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING FISHING AND DIVING

FROM BRIDGES IN PERSON COUNTY

The County of Person, pursuant to North Carolina General Statutes 153A-121 and 153A-242 does hereby enact this ordinance.

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish from or dive from any of the following bridges located within Person County, North Carolina:
  - a) The bridge located on State Road 1556 and crossing Mayo Lake/Mayo Creek.
  - b) The bridge on North Carolina Highway 49 crossing Mayo Lake.
  - c) The bridge on State Road 1512 crossing Mayo Lake.
  - d) The bridge on State Road 1501 crossing Mayo Creek.
  - e) The bridge on State Road 1316 crossing Hyco Lake.
2. Signs shall be posted at prominent locations on both ends of said bridges stating in prominent letters "NO FISHING OR DIVING".
3. Any person who violates this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor subject to a fine not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00), or imprisonment not to exceed 30 days, for each such violation pursuant to North Carolina General Statute 14-4.
4. This ordinance shall be effective on and after 13th day of July, 1983.
