

# Person County Juvenile Crime Prevention Council Request for Proposals

The Juvenile Crime Prevention Council (JCPC) has studied the risk factors and needs of Juvenile Court involved youth in this county and hereby publishes this Request for Proposals. The JCPC anticipates funds from the NC Dept. of Public Safety, Division of Adult Correction and Juvenile Justice in the amount stated above to fund the program types specified below. Such programs will serve delinquent and at-risk youth for the state **fiscal year 2017-2018** beginning on, or after, **July 1, 2017**. The use of these funds in this county **requires a local match** in the amount specified above.

**The JCPC will consider proposals for the following needed programs:**

Restitution/ Community Service	Teen	Mentoring and/or interpersonal skill building

**Proposed program services should target the following risk factors for delinquency or repeat delinquency:**

Of the 120 youth coming to the attention of Juvenile Services, 39% of youth (47 youth) have had one or more referrals to Juvenile Services. Indicators suggest that youth are exhibiting the following behaviors: moderate to serious school behavior problems, negative peer associations including being involved with other delinquent youth, lack of parental supervision, and prior assault history.

**Programs should address the following concerns as reported in the Needs Assessments for adjudicated youth: N=** \_\_\_\_\_

School Domain: 81% of these youth (97) have exhibit moderate to severe school behaviors often leading to suspensions .

Family Domain: 80% of youth possess parents with marginal or inadequate parenting skills. 62% of the youth (74 youth) live in families where family members have criminal histories or a family member is currently under court supervision or gang involved.

Peer Domain: Youth need prosocial skills. 60% of youth (72 youth) are associating with delinquent peers and 5% of youth (6 youth) are associated with gangs.

Individual Domain: 19% of youth (23 youth) are using or abusing substances. 40% of youth (48 youth) have are victims of abuse and 66% (79 youth) have been exposed to domestic discord or violence.

**Applicants are being sought that are able to address items below:**

1. Program services compatible with research that are shown to be effective with juvenile offenders.
2. Program services are outcome-based.
3. The program has an evaluation component.
4. Program services detect gang participation and divert individuals from gang participation.

**Local public agencies, 501(c)(3) non-profit corporations and local housing authorities are invited to submit applications to provide services addressing the above elements.**
